Through lectures and on-the-water practice, students will learn the basics of sailing, rigging, safety, docking, right of way rules, wind conditions and knot tying.

Where:

The LeaderSHIP Program operates out of the CSC facility on the waterfront. All instruction, education materials, and staffing is provided. Transportation is the only thing not included in the program.
