NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1* The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, in the most recent edition.
- 1.2 The rules and regulations of the Community Sailing Center (CSC) will also apply.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The series is open to Club 420 class, and Laser class boats.
- 2.1 The skipper of each boat must pass a CSC rental test.
- 2.2 No instruction or coaching will be provided. All participants must be competent sailors and have knowledge of the racing rules of sailing. Those not actively participating in racing will be asked to return to the dock.
- 2.3 The CSC will provide 420s and Lasers as available. Participants are welcome to bring their own boats and launch from the CSC, but cannot store boats on site.

3 SCHEDULE

- 1700- Registration in-person in the CSC office, boats available first come-first served.
- 1800- First warning signal.
- 1915- No start will be initiated after 1915.

4 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available on 7/15 on the CSC website and in person prior to racing.

5 VENUE

- 5.1 All boats will launch from the CSC docks and check in at the CSC office in person prior to launching.
- 5.2 Racing will take place either north of the CSC between the mooring field and North Beach, or to the west of the Burlington breakwater in the vicinity of "B Can".

6 THE COURSE

The course will be a simple Windward-Leeward course. The starting line will also be the finish line, and the pin of the line will also be the leeward mark. Two laps around with all marks left to port. A diagram will be available in the office during check in.

7 SCORING

Scores will be kept weekly and will not carry over from week to week.

8 SUPPORT BOATS

The CSC committee boat will be anchored on the start/finish line. On the water support will be provided for emergencies only.

9 PRIZES

Weekly winners will be mentioned on CSC social media.

10 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. All competitors are required to submit a Community Sailing Center liability waiver prior to sailing.
