DIVERSITY ACCESS INITIATIVE SCHOLARSHIP

The **Community Sailing Center** is a community-based nonprofit organization providing access, education, and recreation on Lake Champlain for almost 8,000 people annually. We engage our community with the lake through a wide range of educational and recreational programs that extend an open invitation to everyone regardless of age, gender, race, physical ability, or the means to pay.



Community Sailing Center's Diversity Access Scholarship is for children ages 11-15 who identify as BIPOC to participate in summer camps. Our summer camps and youth programs are designed to teach kids the safety, skill, and joy involved in the life-long sport of sailing. Camps run Monday-Friday from 9:00 am to 4:00 pm. Participants can also opt-in to Early Drop Off and Late Pick Up, as well as a transportation stipend of \$30 per week. Participants will start with our introductory camps and returning participants can work their way through our levels and other programs, including Middle School and High School Sailing.



DAI Scholarship recipients will be awarded (at no cost):

- New Sailors: Level 1 and/or Lake Adventure Youth Camps
- Returning Sailors: A two-week Advanced Level Youth Camp, plus Middle School Sailing or High School Sailing
- Availability for early drop-off (before 8am-9am) and late pick-up (4pm-5:30pm) for each week of camp
- \$30 in transportation stipend per week of attendance to support all participants traveling to and from our facility
